# The Heritage Private School and Institute

---

- On the outskirts of Limassol, in over 100 donums of landscaped grounds, the new Heritage Private School and Institute dominate the countryside on a hill off the Limassol to Troodos road.
- The Heritage has always had a high reputation for quality teaching and learning.



# A Brief History of The Heritage Private School and Institute

---

- 1987 The Heritage School began in Moni, a village near Limassol with only six pupils.
- 1988 The School moved from Moni to the centre of Limassol. The number of students increased to twenty-two.
- 1989 The British National Curriculum was introduced to the School. The Kindergarten was created with children from 2 years of age. The number of students increased to fifty.
- 1991 The School had developed the first year of Secondary education. Student numbers became 207 and the staff number increased to 23.
- 1992 The Heritage Private Institute for children began.
- 1994 Twenty donums of land were purchased with the idea of building a new school site. The land is 4.5km north of the Troodos roundabout.



# A Brief History of The Heritage Private School and Institute

---

- 1998 Forty additional donums of land were purchased, adjoining the original purchased land.
- 2000 Architectural plans of the new School were submitted for town-planning permit.
- 2001 Thirty-two donums of additional land were purchased.
- 2004 Permit was given for the building to begin. Building work started on the 1st December 2004.
- 2005 Building work of first phase. Senior rooms and the Primary Department will be completed during this phase, and the sports field will be completed too. An amphitheatre will also be built.
- 2007 September: The school moved to its new buildings. The Heritage Private Institute for Adults began.
