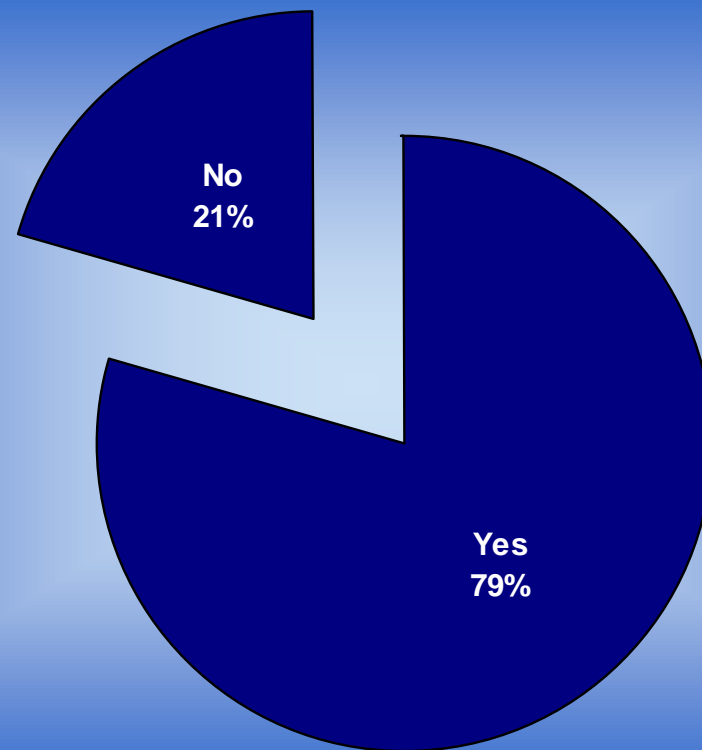
## 39. How do you think people could be encouraged and supported to be more active citizens?

- Raising awareness of opportunities available, promoting cultural events and ensuring businesses provide necessary information for migrants (2)

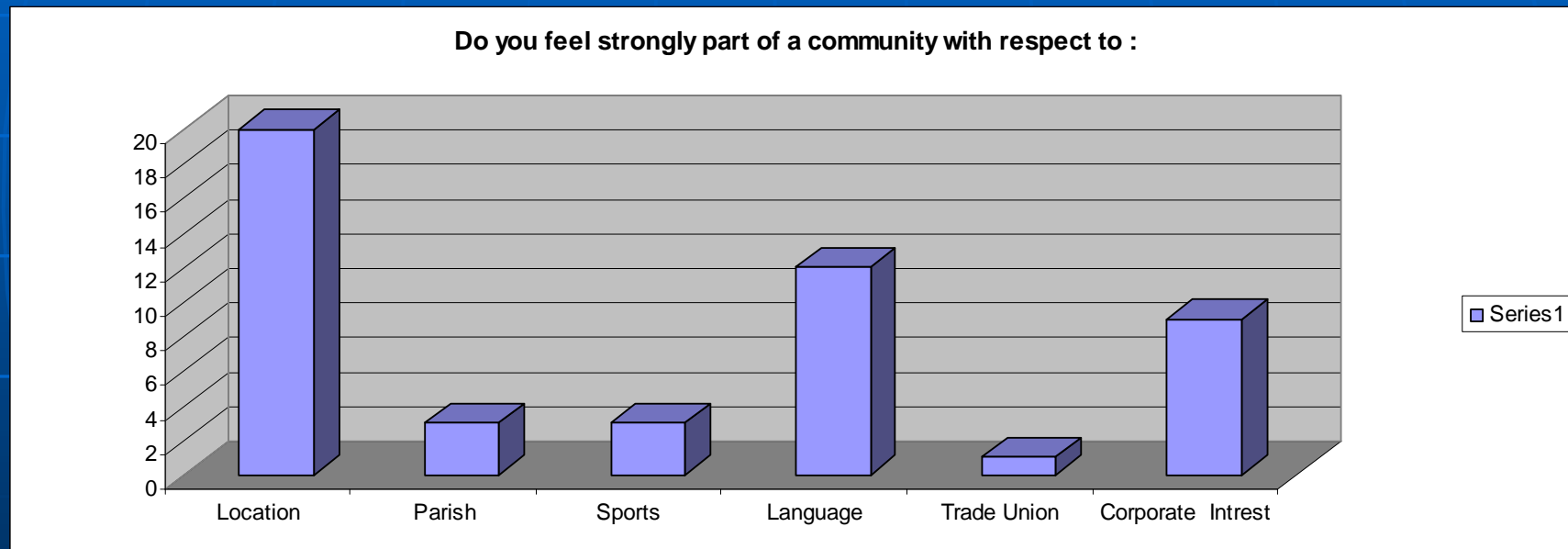

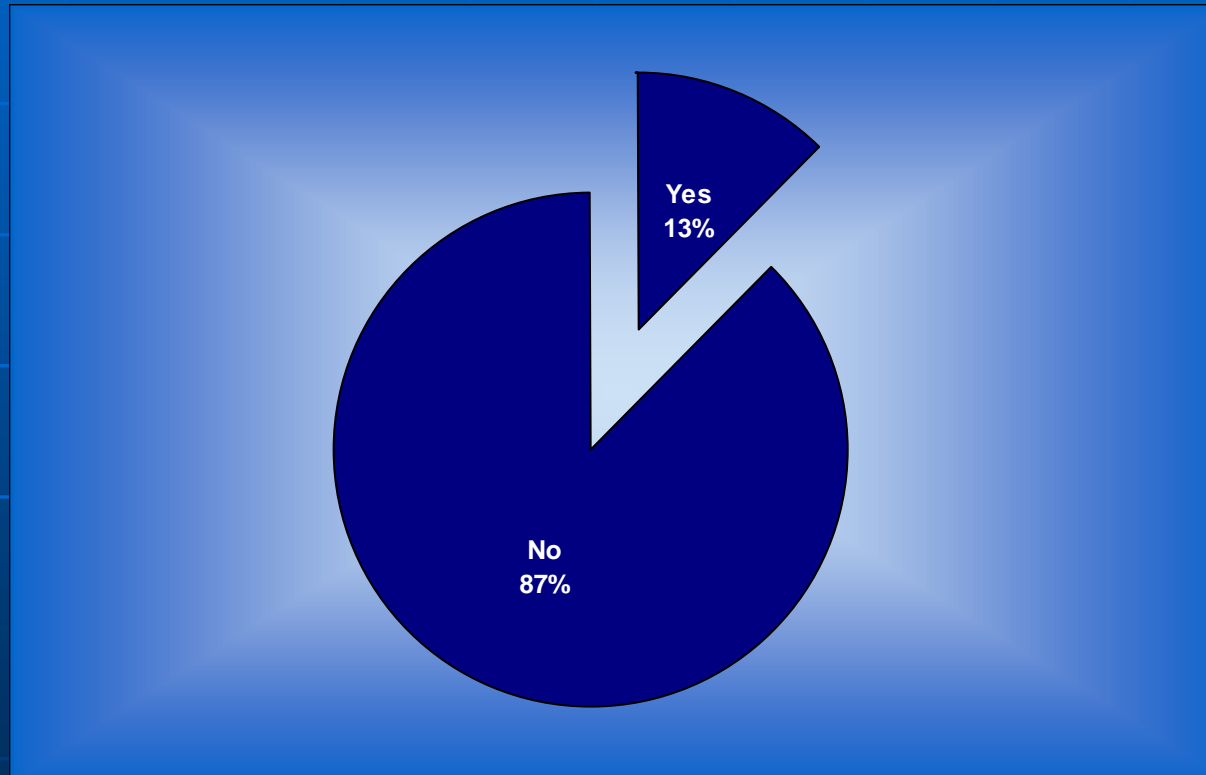

# Limitations of sample

- Our sample predominantly consisted of:
  - British EU migrants
  - Educated people
  - White collar workers
- Insufficient representation from blue collar workers
- Blue collar workers which were approached did not want to participate as they were casual workers who were in Cyprus short term

# Conclusions

- A majority of the respondents have lived in Cyprus for more than five years and are planning on staying long term
- 79% state that they have not received information, support and training which has helped them to become an active citizen

# Conclusions

- There is a need for further information and support in all spheres identified, most notably from central government (laws, policies, voting), culture, public facilities and social
- Furthermore, more effective mediums of communication were requested

# Conclusions

- Many respondents were not fully aware of their rights as EU citizens
- The majority of the respondents who work were happy with their working conditions and many were unaware of the Trade Unions which exist in Cyprus, and few were interested in obtaining information on TUs

# Conclusions

- There is a definite interest in educational training/workshops
- Language is in most demand by far, followed by ICT and Local Culture
